Vacancies for Councillors

Any registered elector living or working within the parish boundary of Shaftesbury or within 3 miles (4.8km) of it may apply for election to Shaftesbury Town Council. Elections are held every four years (the next elections are due in May 2019) but occasional vacancies can occur within that period due to the resignation or departure for any reason of a sitting member. Elections for casual vacancies are only held if ten electors in the relevant ward apply to NDDC for one to be held. If there is no request vacancies are filled by cooption and any contest for a vacancy is decided by a vote of the sitting town council members. For details of how to become a member of Shaftesbury Town Council apply to the Electoral and Committee Officer at North Dorset District Council.

Budget and precept (town council portion of council tax) setting process

2016

September	Each Committee considers and estimates for its capital projects for the next financial year.
September	Clerk prepares revenue budget proposals on a base budget methodology and incorporates capital project wish list to create overall budget and precept based on committee requests.
September /October	The proposed revenue budget and capital project wishlist is put to a Council budget workshop. The Budget workshop recommends a draft budget and precept for debate at a public open evening.
November	The proposed budget is put to the General Management Committee to consider outcomes of the public meeting and recommends a budget and precept to Full Council.
December	Full Council debates and ratifies budget and sets precept request

2017

January	Clerk makes precept request to NDDC
February	NDDC sets precept (council tax) for council year starting on 1 st April 2017
